TCAM Public Site

The *TCAM* (Telecommunications Conformity Assessment and Market Surveillance Committee) is the standing Committee assisting the Commission in the management of Directive 99/5/EC. This Interest Group was set-up to facilitate the exchange of documents between Member States and the Commission.

The *TCAM CAPD* group will discuss matters, related to Communications Access for People with Disabilities, that have been referred to the group by TCAM. Membership of the group is available by invitation to European organisations involved in communications and disability issues.

The *TCAM Disabilities group* has been established to ensure that mainstream telecommunications products are accessible to people with special needs. Several working groups have been established and can exchange documents using this site.
